Job advertisement about 2 fulltime positions
at the national training center / regional training center in Munich (f/m/d)

The German Judo-Federation (DJB) and the Bavarian Judo-Association (BJV) are looking for

2 success oriented JUDO COACHES

in fulltime to support the high performance athletes at the national / regional training center in Munich in order to strengthen the current team of coaches. First day of employment is planned to be 15th of September 2020.

The central mission of the first position consists of the coordination, steering and execution of the high performance training of the male senior national Judo squad athletes in order to specifically prepare those athletes for the Olympic Games 2024

The central mission of second position consists of the coordination, steering and execution of the high performance training of male junior (under 21) national Judo squad and the top regional athletes in order to participate successfully at Junior European- and Junior World Championships and develop senior squad athletes.

The holder of each position performs the daily training of the dedicated athletes in accordance with the assigned national coach and the director of the national training center. Furthermore, you supervise your athletes during national and international competitions. Part of your job description is to cooperate closely with the national- and regional coaches and with adjacent age groups. You will also represent other coaches during their absence.

Qualification: The selected candidates are expected to

- Demonstrate experience as a high performance coach verified by national / international results with junior or senior level athletes.
- Show a working history with national team squad- and top regional athletes. Knowledge about the German high performance structure is beneficial.
- M.sc. / B.sc. of Sport Science or related fields are beneficial.
- A minimum of the German DOSB Level-A Coaching License, DJB Level A-License or comparable international coaching license, or the readiness to achieve this level rapidly is required.
- Willingness to have flexible working hours, including weekend work.
- Exceptional commitment, ability to work under pressure, capacity for teamwork, and reliability.
- High competency in strategic planning, and communication.
- Profound knowledge of modern ways of communication technology and common software applications.
- German or international driving license and good-conduct certificate.
- For working processes German language is required; English communication is beneficial.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Sole responsible and success-oriented planning, steering and performance of daily training for dedicated athletes, in collaboration with the national and regional coaches and the director of the training center.
- Planning, organization, performance and evaluation of regional- and national and international measures in collaboration with related personnel.
- Supervision of athletes during competition and training courses nationally and internationally.
- The second position is obliged to perform training courses at adjacent regional training centers of different age groups and genders.
- Success oriented collaboration with personnel of the German- and Bavarian Judo Federation
