IJF - YOUTH TRAINING CAMP NATSU 2025



INTRODUCTION

Under the umbrella of the International Judo Federation (IJF) and the Olympic **Solidarity** (OS), **Sergei Judo Camp Association** (SJC) organizes the 11th International training camp for Cadets.

The camp will take place in Fiesch, Switzerland, from 20 to 26 July 2025.

IJF-YOUTH TRAINING CAMP 2025

During this week, more than 300 athletes from around the world will gather together on the tatami. It is an opportunity for these young judokas to diversify their workouts, under the supervision and expertise of experienced coaches of the world.

Among the staff, you can count on the participation of several Olympic and / or world and continental medallists.

Moreover, the participants' coaches will also be involved in training.







WORKSHOPS

FOR THE ATHLETES

Every morning, the judokas will enjoy a **technical training**, which will be given by a medallist coach. He will present his favourite techniques.

Various current themes will be presented during exhibitions in the "Athletes' Lounge."

FOR THE COACHES

Various briefings and exchanges (medical commission, refereeing, ...) will be organized in the "Coaches' Lounge"

RANDORIS

Many randori sessions will be scheduled during the week. They will be specifically adapted to the preparation of World Championships.

TEAM WORK

Sessions will be available for coaches to do their own work separately with their team, enjoying the infrastructure of the centre.

DISCOVERY

During the week, **a half-day "discovery"** will be organized. Under a playful and cultural form, you will discover our region and its traditions.

FIESCH

Located in the heart of Valais in Switzerland, this small mountain village situated at an altitude of 1,050 m offers all the necessary conditions for quality training.

Part of the World Heritage of the UNES-CO, Fiesch has at the entrance of the village a training centre, originally planned to be Olympic village. It can accommodate nearly 1,000 athletes where they can train, eat and sleep in optimal conditions. The whole facility extends over an area of approx. 20'000 m².





INFRASTRUCTURES

Full board, participants have at their disposal a 1,200 m² dojo and pool, sauna, basketball court, beach volleyball and skate park. Other paying activities are available such as squash, mini-golf course in the trees...

All meals are included during the stay in the restaurant of the training centre.

The centre has a dormitory with 4, 8 or 10 beds capacity. The distribution will done by SJC based on the number of participants. **Bedding is included**

Apart from training, the coaches can come and share their experience and relax in a coaches' lounge.

Please note that teams should bring their own towels, although they are available upon request.



TRANSPORTS




From Geneva airport, shuttle bus es will be provided on arrival day and at the end of the camp. They will be available for free for the participants to the training centre.
